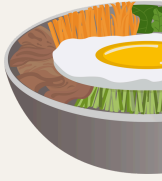

# WHAT KOREAN THINGS DO YOU LIKE?

## Food

1. Kimchi- An essential fermented dish made from vegetables (most commonly cabbage) and spices
2. Bibimbap- A well-balanced bowl of rice topped with colorful vegetables, meat, and a fried egg, and mixed with gochujang (spicy chili paste).
3. Korean chicken(chimaek)- Popular for being extra crispy, this chicken is often double-fried and glazed in sweet, savory, or spicy sauce.
4. Korean BBQ (specifically samgyeopsal or galbi)- A dinner time dish here, grill meat- such as pork belly or marinated ribs- at their table, wrapping with lettuce and sauce.
5. Tteokbokki (spicy rice cakes)- A beloved street food staple featuring chewy rice cakes cooked in a spicy, slightly sweet chili sauce, often paired with fish cakes.



## SNACKS

1. Kkobuk Chips- A snack that has two flavours (corn and chocolate) The snack is piled in four layers. It's crunchy and has addiction.
2. Yakgwa- a Korean national and traditional food which is a deep-fried honey cookie.
3. Homerun ball ( a lot of flavors)- a ball filled up with chocolate, milk and more.
4. Poca chip- this is a snack that has a thin layer and gives a deep flavour.
5. Choco songi ( Has strawberry and chocolate)- a small mushroom snack that has a stick come out and on top of the stick is a mushroom like chocolate



## ICE-CREAM,

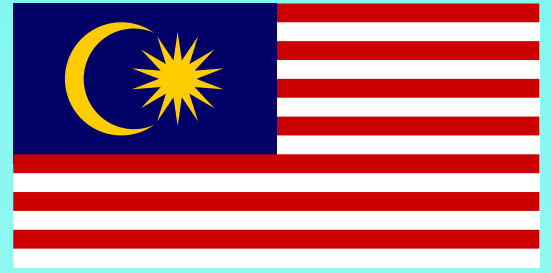
1. Melona(melon flavor)-Famous for its smooth, creamy texture and distinct honeydew melon flavor.
